

The Use Of Television Inspection For The Assessment Of Visual Lean Percentage
In Meat And For The Assessment Of Yield In Carcass Beef

The paper will discuss the concept of the use of television image analysis in the field of meat inspection. Initially from the point of view of the assessment of the percentage content of fat in slabbed beef and secondly for its use in the routine assessment of yield grade in a beef carcass by the inspection of the rib eye. A technical outline of the instrumentation used will be given as well as an indication of other areas of application in the meat industry.

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
